Taking **Action**:

Interact with Community Leaders

Recognize that community leaders track calls and emails. This is how they gauge the importance of an issue.

Make calls or send emails OFTEN to elected representatives.

Ask them to lead from these common beliefs.

Ask them to take specific action on specific issues.

Connect regularly with a local group to support each other and take regular action.

Practice Talking to people!

Connect one on one.

Understand where someone stands. Step into their shoes.

Be curious about why they believe what they do.

Share your story. Discover common ground.

If you get stuck, take a break, reflection always helps.

Recognize that:

Others are just as right as you are from their lens.

Standing on facts is not helpful when we are entrenched.

Listening and connection are what matter, by far.

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Nudge Faith Leaders

Whatever you believe, encourage your leaders to lead toward common ground.

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Actively reach out to other faiths and build relationships.

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Hold leaders accountable to find common ground.
